

Visitor Safety

- The Intermodal Group are committed to the safety of all employees, contractors and visitors. Whenever you are at one of our terminals you are required to observe the safety procedures contained in this presentation or provided in a booklet.
- You will be made aware of our operations, restricted areas and procedures to be followed.
- You must report any injury, near miss or damage however minor to the manager or supervisor prior to leaving the site.
- Vehicles must be parked in vehicle parking areas only.

FIT Operations

- FIT is an Intermodal Terminal and as such heavy plant (trucks, trains and forklifts) operate throughout the terminal.
- Containers are stored on site, normally in block stacks, which can range up to 6 containers in height.
- Containers are cleaned and repaired on site which involves welding, spray painting and high pressure cleaning.
- There is a fumigation facility for imported containers.
- The terminal is licensed as a bond depot.

NQRT Operations

- NQRT is an Intermodal Terminal and as such heavy plant (trucks, trains and forklifts) operate throughout the terminal.
- Containers are stored on site, normally in block stacks, which can range up to 5 containers in height.
- There is a fumigation facility for imported containers.
- The terminal is licensed as a bond depot.

Access

- FIT and NQRT are customs controlled areas and as such entry is restricted. Goods and vehicles may be searched.
- Pedestrian access for visitors is limited to the office and amenities areas.
- Site tours can be arranged subject to operational requirements and will only be conducted in the presence of an employee.

Site Safety Rules

- Visitors shall obey all and any direction given by an employee, in accordance with that person's duties and responsibilities.
- Hi visibility clothing or safety vests must be worn whilst you are in the terminal.
- The use of Mobile Phones is not permitted whilst in control of *any* vehicle.
- Walkmans/iPods must not be used in the operational areas.
- Visitors are not permitted to operate any machinery without permission from the manager.
- Do not under any circumstances enter or attempt to enter any fumigation areas when the fumigation danger signs are displayed.
- Visitors must remain 6 metres from container stacks and operating forklifts at all times.
- Visitors must not approach a forklift with a suspended load.
- 10 KPH site Speed limit.
- Visitors must remain more than 3 meters from the rail lines.

Emergency Evacuation

- Familiarise yourself with the site plan.
- Note the location of the Emergency Assembly area.
- If an alarm is raised, remain calm and remove yourself from any immediate danger.
- Assemble at the Emergency assembly area.
- Await instructions from the Supervisor.
